Counselor's Corner

Warren Elementary's Virtue of the Month Program-
March: Self-Discipline
The Gift of Character: Self-Discipline

Warren Elementary is continuing our virtues language program. Students are embracing these virtues and complimenting each other for demonstrating them. For the month of March our main virtue is self-discipline. Self-discipline means doing what you need to do and what is important to you, rather than being distracted by what is not your focus and purpose. Showing self-discipline involves taking care of your body and making good, healthy choices. We

exercise, drink water and eat fruits and vegetables. We do not eat unhealthy food until we feel sick. We do not stay up too late and play video games, watch videos or play on phones. We get enough sleep and remember to be healthy. We are diligent about thinking about our goals and how to go to college, so we can get the career we want one day. We practice with determination, so we can do sports, play an instrument, be a dancer, be a gymnast, or perform in a play if we want to do that. We believe in ourselves, our integrity, and our ability to succeed. self-discipline goes very well with the virtue of the month for February, perseverance, because we keep trying and do not give up on ourselves.
